Bench Rate

You will find fixed rate pricing for most services in this guide. For services that do not have a fixed rate, we use a bench rate of **\$120 per hour (\$2 per minute) with a minimum charge of \$30**. Customers must pre-approve a repair estimate when checking-in the repair. We will always contact you if we expect the repair to exceed your pre-approved amount.

Incidental Repairs and \$50 Pre-Approval

Our setups are comprehensive (details on next page). However, sometimes minor repairs are required in order to properly setup the instrument. Incidental repairs to deal with damaged hardware, loose frets, or worn nut slots are often needed to ensure the best possible setup.

A \$50 pre-approval is required to cover these incidental services, should they be needed.

These services will only be performed when it's absolutely necessary to properly set up the instrument. If no incidental services are needed, you will not be charged.

By giving a pre-approval amount, you help us complete your instrument as quickly as possible, and ensure the best possible setup.

Setup Details

A complete set-up includes:

- Restring (Strings priced separately)
- Tighten and lubricate all hardware
- Clean and condition fingerboard
- Polish frets to remove corrosion
- Cleaning of entire guitar
- Adjust truss-rod to correct neck relief
- Adjust saddle radius
- Adjust string height at bridge
- File nut slots for proper height and string movement
- Adjust intonation
- Adjust tremolo bridge setting to player's preference.
- Clean and test electronics
- Replace battery if needed (priced separately)
- Adjust or rehang loose wiring
- Adjust pickup balance
- Full inspection and play test
- Banjo setups include tuning the head to pitch

Action Preferences

Our technicians will default to the L&M Spec Action listed below. We are happy to use a custom action requested by the customer, with the understanding that it may affect other aspects of the guitar's performance.

L&M Spec Action

Spec action is a general guideline for a wide variety of manufacturers. It will vary depending on the model, condition of the fingerboard, choice of strings, and tuning. Any deviation more than 1/64th will be noted in the technician's comments.

Fret-leveling and refret work must be combined with a setup with pre-approval for incidentals (see page 3).

Refrets include leveling of the fingerboard and shimming of the original nut, If a new nut is required we will contact you to discuss options.

Partial refrets include partial fret leveling to blend the refretted area.

All prices are for non-cosmetic repairs. Cosmetic repair options may be available for an additional charge; ask us for an estimate.

Nut Replacement

To ensure proper performance, a nut replacement must be combined with a setup and the recommended pre-approval for incidentals (see page 3).

Prices do not include finish touch-up; Lacquered-over nuts will be replaced as carefully as possible to leave a clean result.

Cosmetic-repair options may be available for an additional charge; ask us for an estimate.

Locking nut installation includes mounting and shimming, but does not include routing of the neck, if such modification is required there will be an additional charge.





Bridge & Saddle Replacement – Electric Guitar or Bass

Saddle or bridge replacement must be combined with a setup and the recommended pre-approval for incidentals (see page 3).

Note that most Gibson style Tune-o-matic saddles and bridges do not come with a string notch and will be subject to the additional charge.

Prices are for direct replacement only and do not include routing, drilling or replacement of anchors.

Electronic Diagnosis and Repair

A **pre-approval of \$100** is required for all electronic diagnosis and repair. We will always contact you with an estimate if we expect the repair to exceed \$100.

If the source of the problem is not known, you will be charged for the time to diagnose and complete the repair. We use a bench rate of **\$120 per hour (\$2 per minute) with a minimum charge of \$30.**

For repairs that require part replacement, you will be charged for diagnostic time and parts replacement, according to the table in the following section *Electronic Component Replacement*.

If we are unable to reproduce the problem, or extensive diagnosis is required a \$35 Repair Assessment fee may be charged.

Electronic Component Replacement

Component replacement requires a Base Fee of \$30 plus the component cost. For example, the labour for replacing a pot and an output jack costs \$55 (\$30 base price + \$10 output jack price + \$15 control pot price) Adding a new mini-switch to a Les Paul would be \$ (\$30 base price + \$25 mini switch price + \$25 new mounting hole in a solid body price). In both cases, the cost of parts would be extra. The base price is waved if you are having pickups installed.

Switching from passive to active pickups requires installation of control pots, output jack and a battery. If no battery is provided, a Duracell battery will be added to the bill. Prices do not include routing or modification of the body. Many pickup systems feature a solder-less quick connect system, this can be bypassed for a traditional soldered connection if desired.
